The proposed development comprises seven horizontal access wind turbines (four with a maximum tip height of 149.9m and three with a maximum tip height of 130m), improved site entrance, new access tracks, crane hardstandings, control building and substation compound, electricity transformers, underground cabling, energy storage containers, drainage works and upgrades to a forestry track and associated felling.

To avoid the need to consult Rhondda Cynon Taf Council County Borough Council, the planning application boundary on the eastern side of the access track, between approximate Ordnance Survey grid references 29059 19852 and 29169 19570 will be moved to avoid extending across the boundary between Neath Port Talbot and Rhondda Cynon Taf, such that the whole of the planning application boundary along the access track will lie within Neath Port Talbot.
